 - Two due dates changed recently. Annual report to DOR was Jan 31 each year, moved to Apr 15 in 2020. Annual report to Seattle was Jan 31 each year, moved to Apr 30 in 2021.
 - Submitting a 'report' means filling out online or paper forms. Sometimes, taxes will be due, sometimes not. You still must submit a report, even if no taxes are due.
